UEG Education Partnership Programme: Call for Applications

On behalf of United European Gastroenterology, we are pleased to invite all UEG Member Societies to participate in the **UEG Education Partnership Programme (UEPP)**.

The programme has been established to support high-quality educational projects in digestive health that address educational gaps, cover minority topics and contribute to the advancement of digestive health education across Europe. Through the UEPP, UEG acts as a co-organiser together with its Member Societies and aims to strengthen collaboration in the delivery of relevant and impactful educational activities. All relevant information, including programme objectives, eligibility criteria, funding principles and responsibilities of participating societies, is outlined in the [UEPP Outline & Criteria](#). Please review this document carefully before submission.

We warmly invite you to collaborate with UEG and submit educational projects that align with the objectives of the programme.

The total annual budget available for the UEPP is **€200,000**. The maximum UEG co-funding per application is:

- €15,000 for activities organised by one Member Society.
- €25,000 for joint activities involving two or more Member Societies.

Applications must be submitted at least **three months** prior to the educational activity. As an exception, applications for activities taking place in **2026** may be submitted up to **one month** before the event. Applications are reviewed by the **UEPP Taskforce**, composed of members of the UEG Council and led by Independent Councillor **Enrique de-Madaria**. The Taskforce evaluates each application against the objectives and criteria of the programme and decides on the allocation of UEG financial support. Applicants will be informed of the outcome within **4–6 weeks** after submission.
